ACCESS TO THE PROPERTY AND PARKING INFORMATION

The apartment is located in the *restricted traffic zone* (ZTL). Car access to the area is allowed only at certain times which vary at each point of entry. The nearest point of entry is **Via Fornello Casale**.

Parking inside the ZTL is for local residents only, however at certain times of the day visitors can park within the blue lines in Via Fornello Casale and the nearby Via Marco Aurelio. Please check the signs for parking times and pay at one of the “pay and display” ticket machines available.

Long term parking solutions:

- **"PARKEJOO"** underground indoor parking in Viale Michele de Pietro n.1 (400m walking distance). Well lit, with 24/7 video surveillance, toilets, snacks and daytime receptionist. Visit www.parkejoo.com for tariffs and possible long term parking discounts.
- **"EX GIL"** outdoor gated car park in Via Adua n.16, near Porta Napoli (450 m walking distance). Check at the ticket office for tariffs and long stay discounts.
- In the nearby **Via VITTORIO MARIO STAMPACCHIA** and **Via ARGENTO** (500m walking distance) you can park for free within the blue lines but only at certain times of day. Check street signs for times and tariffs.

HOUSE RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

Welcome to **Corte dei Florio**!

We provide some free amenities on arrival for your convenience. For further necessities, you will find details of the nearest shops and supermarkets in the following pages.

All our apartments are strictly non-smoking. Smoking is allowed in the outdoor areas and ashtrays are provided. No candles or other naked flames allowed anywhere in the building.

We do some recycling: plastic, glass, paper and mixed refuse. You will find labelled bins inside the apartment for mixed, glass and plastic. If needed, you can empty them in the larger, labelled bins found inside the blue cabinet at the bottom of the stairs in the main hall. You can leave any recycling paper inside the apartment for the housekeeper to dispose of.

Please be energy-conscious and remember to turn off any lights, air conditioning or heating when you go out for the day. Also please ensure that no taps are left running by mistake.

Please flush only toilet paper down the toilet. A waste bin is provided in each bathroom for items such as sanitary towels, q-tips, wipes etc.

Please be mindful of other resident guests: no loud music, loud noises or other disturbances, especially at night.

Checkout is by 10am on departure day. Please leave any key sets on the kitchen table and simply pull the door shut behind you when you are ready. IMPORTANT: always make sure that you have taken all your belongings with you before closing the door.

FOOD&DRINK

You will be spoilt for choice in the Old Town, but here are some old favourites to get you started. Try the traditional “pasticciotto” cake, the “rustico” (savory puff pastry stuffed with bechamel, tomato and mozzarella), and enjoy a “caff  leccese” (espresso with almond milk) or a cocktail with rich appetizers, known as “aperitivo rinforzato”.

SALENTO SIGHTSEEING

The Salento region is rich in history and natural beauty and there would be much to explore. What follows are details of the main coastal towns, but a drive along the “litoranea” (coastal road) on either side of the peninsula will reveal many beautiful spots, like **Castro**, **Tricase**, **Santa Maria di Leuca**, the **Cesine** or the **Porto Selvaggio** natural reserves to name but a few. Also of note the beautiful old towns of **Nardò** and **Galatina**, the Byzantine Cathedral of **Santa Maria delle Cerrate**, and the many ancient villages of the **Grecia salentina**, where a form of Greek dialect is still spoken today.

Here are some suggestions.

COSTA ADRIATICA – EAST COAST

OTRANTO – discover its white-washed, Greece-like alleyways, the Roman style Cathedral featuring the largest floor mosaic in Europe, the *Aragonese* Castle (now a museum), and a beautiful seaside promenade. The beach is accessible directly from the city centre.
